RESOLUTION NO.286

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 281; TO ADOPT THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1995-96; AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council has voted to borrow from the State Revolving Loan Fund to finance a wastewater facilities master plan study; and

WHEREAS, the loan agreement requires a loan reserve account to be in place at the time the City begins to draw upon the loan; and

WHEREAS, the receipt and expenditure of the loan proceeds and the establishment of a loan reserve account were not anticipated in the Fiscal Year 1994-95 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council has by Resolution No. 285 caused the establishment of a water reserve fund and a sewer operating fund and the dissolution of LID #2 fund, all effective July 1, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated beginning cash on hand in several funds varied greatly from the amount budgeted for Fiscal year 1995-96 due to lack of up-to-date accounting information at the time of budget preparation; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Aurora City Council hereby adopts the Supplemental Budget for Fiscal Year 1995-96, on file in the office of the City Recorder.

BE IT RESOLVED, the amounts for the Fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995 to June 30, 1996, for the purposes shown and appropriated in Resolution No. 281 are hereby amended as follows:
