RESOLUTION NO. 333

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING JURISDICTION OF CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY NEEDED TO BUILD THE MARION COUNTY EHLEN ROAD REALIGNMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, City of Aurora/Marion County Intergovernmental Agreement No. 14,824 calls for the City to transfer all City right-of-way needed to build the project to the county's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Marion County has asked for an additional portion of City-owned property necessary to complete the Marion County Ehlen Road Realignment project, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Aurora City Council approves the City right-of-way transfers to Marion County as follows:

Section 1. The City of Aurora hereby transfers jurisdiction of all City right-of-way needed to build the Marion County Ehlen Road Realignment Project to Marion County pursuant to the terms of the City of Aurora/Marion County Intergovernmental Agreement No. 14.824, and as contained in Marion County Exhibit C, sheets 1 and 2.

The City Council hereby directs the Mayor or Council President to execute any documents necessary to execute the transfer.

Section 2. The City of Aurora hereby transfers jurisdiction of that portion of City-owned property known as Tax Lot 1500, Map #4-1W-12CD as contained in Marion County Exhibit C, sheets 1 and 2.

The City Council hereby directs the Mayor or Council President to execute any documents necessary to execute the transfer.

Right of Way for Marion County
